Subject: Supply of car for physically handicapped customers on concessional rate of excise duty-regarding.

Reference is invited to this Department guidelines No. 12/35/2007-AEI dated ___ March, 2007 on the above mentioned subject. Based on these guidelines, the applications for issue of excise duty concession certificate were considered. The Government is working towards simplification of Government procedure for abolition of affidavits and promotion of self-certification wherever possible. Accordingly, the procedures adopted in these guidelines have been revisited and it has been decided to amend para 2(c) of this Department letter No. 12/35/2007-AEI dated ___ March, 2007 as under:-

“the applicants gives self-certification that he/she had not availed of this concession in the last 5 years and that he will not dispose of the cars with excise duty concession after purchase for a period of 5 years”

2. This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.
